

2A. English

Aim

In Level 2A, students complete their study of the Kumon English 'Word Building Block'. Students begin to read whole passages and stories. Their ability to write and spell words independently is greatly improved during this level. The worksheets have been designed so that students who need assistance in completing the exercises can turn back to the previous worksheet to find some help. Students will stop this practice automatically as their confidence increases. The contents of Level 2A are outlined below

No.	Topic	Description
1-10	Word Puzzle	In this section, students concentrate on writing words to improve their comprehension and spelling. Students select words to complete sentences correctly. Many basic spelling patterns are revised to ensure they have been mastered.

61-70	Function of Words	Students are introduced to nouns, verbs and adjectives. The purpose of the section is for students to be able to use different words to form sentences. The students do not need to learn the terminology or definitions at this stage. Students will be exposed to single and plural nouns, basic classification of words, simple subject-verb agreement and positive, comparative and superlative adjectives.

151-160	Oral Reading	Each set of ten worksheets contains all or part of a well known children's story. Three of the stories are traditional – <i>Jack and the Beanstalk</i> , <i>Peter and the Wolf</i> and <i>Robinson Crusoe</i> . The other two – <i>We're Going on a Bear Hunt</i> and <i>Mr Gumpy's Outing</i> are featured on the Kumon Recommended Reading List. As all the stories are at an appropriate level of reading complexity, students will be able to enjoy reading them independently. The instructor will show students how to estimate their reading times and use the 'time box' on the reading pages.
